#### MEMBER SELECTION AND REQUIREMENTS

· Members will be selected from the applications by a jury comprised of current exhibiting Micropolis members

after receipt of application, images and \$25 fee. The fee will be returned if artist is not invited to join the cooperative.

### PROPOSED WORK SCHEDULE

• The art co-op will be staffed as many days as possible, with the hope that eventually a member will be in the gallery each day of the month to assist shoppers, maintain the gallery space, and update the books. Member artists will work a minimum of 6 hours a month. Two 3-hour shifts or three 2-hour shifts per month suggested.

#### OTHER CATEGORIES FOR PARTICIPATION

- Patron and vendor membership categories are available on our website (www.micropolisgallery.com) if you are interested in participating on a level other than artist member.
- 1. Scope of Agency. The artist appoints the gallery to act as the artist's exclusive agent in Gloversville.
- 2. Commissions. The gallery will receive a commission of 20% of the retail price of each work sold.

  In the case of discount sales, the discount will be deducted from the gallery's commission, not from the artist's earnings.
- **3. Prices.** The artist will set the retail price of the work.
- **4. Payments.** Micropolis Gallery will pay the artist all proceeds due to the artist at the end of each month.
- 5. Accounting. The artist will provide Micropolis Gallery a list of all works for display which includes title, medium, description, and retail price.
- **6. Display.** Only work of the style and type that has been juried will be displayed. New types of work may be presented to the jury of exhibiting member artists at a membership meeting for approval to be displayed. Member artists will receive priority wall space over vendor artists.
- 7. Loss or Damage. Although every effort will be made to insure the safety of work displayed at the gallery, the gallery cannot be responsible for any work lost or damaged.
- **8. Tax Forms.** According to current IRS procedures, artists will be required to complete a W9 form. Micropolis will issue a 1099 form to each artist with over \$600 in earnings from the sale of work at Micropolis.
